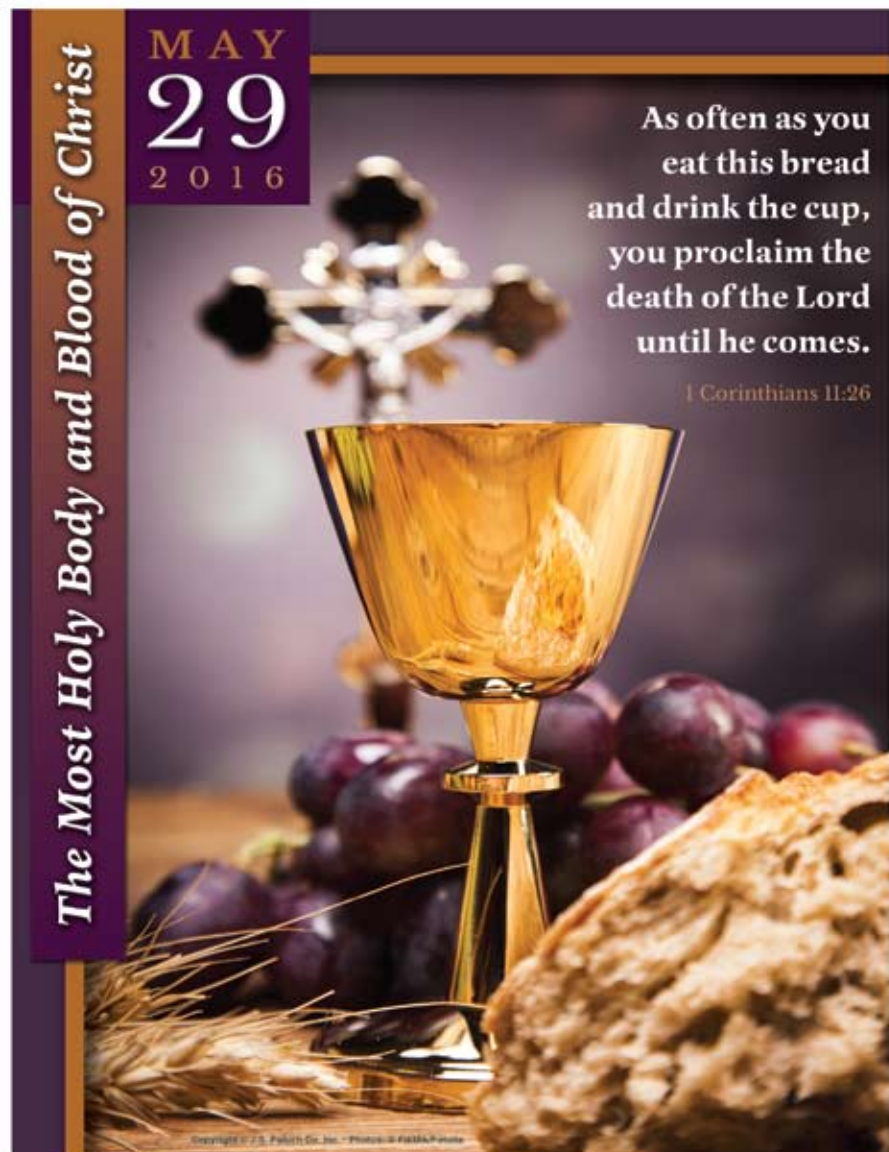

Change in Eucharistic Procession

As the Year of Mercy ends on the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King, the Eunice Catholic Pastors decided to transfer our Eucharistic Procession to Christ the King Sunday. That means **we do not have a Eucharistic Procession this Sunday, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.** It is St. Thomas More Church's turn to sponsor the procession. It should be cooler at that time. Also as St. Thomas More Church in being renovated, it makes it convenient to do the procession in November. We thank you for your understanding.

Gospel for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Cycle C - Luke 9:11b – 17

“And when the left over fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets.” Today's Gospel shows us that Jesus wants to do more than satisfy our needs. Jesus wants to give us an experience of fullness and abundance. Jesus not only miraculously fed the crowd of thousands; Jesus also provided enough to make a mountain of leftovers. Jesus provided more that they needed, more that they ever expected. That is what Jesus gave. It is what he continues to give us every time we receive the Eucharist. This too is a miraculous meal. Like the multiplication of five loaves and two fish, Jesus turns something small – bread and wine – into

something abundant and overflowing: his body, blood, soul, and divinity.

Through this sacrament we experience the gift of union with Jesus and the resulting graces that come from encountering him. Just like the crowds gathered that day in a deserted place, we come to Jesus with our emptiness – our needs, our weaknesses, our fears – and Jesus fills us up until we too are “satisfied”. Receiving the Lord in the Eucharist is a momentous miracle and an earthly glimpse into heaven. May today's celebration help remind us to be ever grateful for this most glorious gift.

Genesis 14:18 – 20: How do you offer a tithing to God for the gifts you have received?

1 Corinthians 11:23 - 26: Why do you think Jesus placed such a high priority on the Eucharistic meal being “in remembrance of me”?
